

# RED HIGH IMPACT ZONE

Macro MOOP (Bags of garbage, bar counters, bricks etc) found in these areas. Whoever leaves this much behind needs some education. Leaving MOOP of any kind is not very Burner, as we respect ourselves and our environment. Have your Trash Plan in place, be Radically Self Reliant and take all your MOOP back! A red listing means chances of getting the same placement again are pretty much zero.

### YELLOW MODERATE IMPACT ZONE

These areas were not Micro MOOPed at all. Get closer to the Earth and notice all those cable ties, cigarette butts and glow sticks.

Make a MOOP line and do a line sweep before you leave.

With just a little effort your camp could be green giving you first priority in terms of placement at next year's event.

# GREEN LOW OR NO IMPACT ZONE

#### A = awesome!

Well done - now teach your neighbours to do the same.

### BLUE DRIVE-BY MOOP ZONE

When an otherwise pristine **GREEN** campsite has MOOP dumped in it by **other** unscrupulous participants on their way out of the burn.
