

## Jungle Jepp AfrikaBurn 2020

Joining Procedures: Joining: call Tankwa Tower on 120.2 MHz at 10NM for joining instructions. Have your allocation number ready.

**Caution high terrain** to the north-east of the field.

Tankwa Town is a no-fly zone: don't overfly Tankwa Town or it's associated artworks less than 3000'AGL. Aircraft operating near perimeter of this area should maintain a safe lateral distance away from the boundary.

**Ground Movement:** Obtain ATC clearance to use the runway, including entering, backtracking, or crossing.

All arriving aircraft must first proceed to the Alpha Apron for processing at the Terminal. before repositioning. Clearance for repositioning can be obtained from ATC.

**Dust and Noise:** Prop-wash can easily create a flurry of dust and stones that can be dangerous to others and even yourself. Be mindful of what effect this may have.

A metal-surfaced run-up pad is available but get clearance from ATC before using it (because of proximity to the runway)

Try avoid run-ups near the terminal and try reduce your noise impact on Tankwa Town in general.

At own risk: don't land here if you haven't read and understood the disclamer published on the AfrikaBurn website.

**Secure your aircraft:** Bring your own tiedowns; secure your controls; cover up engine intakes and static ports.

**Extreme Environment:** dust can reduce visibility quickly. Storms can come up quickly and even rain is not unexpected. Landing surface is unpaved and subject to environmental conditions. Hospitals are far away. Let someone know your planned flight details; it helps rescuers if you need to be found. Have suitable alternates planned. Take water and survival gear in case you land in an unplanned location: the desert is hot and dry. Come prepared.

**No facilities:** no tie-downs, no cell signal, no fuel, no oil, no maintenance engineers, and no battery backup. There's just you, the desert, and a great adventure. Radical self-reliance is required.

**Get your allocation number:** this is a private airstrip on private property and prior permission is required.

No ticket, no entry, no exceptions. No tickets sold at the gate.

## Tankwa Int'l Airport 1040'amsl 32°20.055'S 019°45.208'E

Joining procedures As per ATC on 120.2 MHz.

**Unmanned procedures:** route inbound at 3000'AGL or above. Position overhead the field to establish runway-in-use. Descend to the south east of the runway and join the circuit. Vacate the runway and park on Alpha apron. Broadcast intentions on 120.2 and 124.8.

**No overflying AfrikaBurn:** Circuits always to the east. Don't overfly Tankwa Town or its artworks less than 3000'AGL.

**Waypoints:** Provided only for reference. Bring an up-to-date map and be prepared to navigate without your GPS. No IFR facilities available. Input of GPS coordinates recommended *before* flight.

**Ongeluks River ford:** 32°29.183'S019°50.069'E South, where the Ongeluks river crosses a dirt road

Tankwa confluence: 32°18.625'S 019°33.163'E West, where Tankwa, Tra-Tra, and Doring Rivers meet.

**R355 north:** 32°10.276'S 019°42.764'E On the R355, ±10NM north of Tankwa Int'l

 32°29.314'S 019°40.763'E

 On the R355, ±10NM south of Tankwa Int'l
